

e-TOURIST VISA (eTV)



1. With effect from 15 August 2015, Mozambique has been included in the group of countries that is eligible for e-Tourist Visa (eTV) facility made available by the Government of India. Details of the scheme including documentation required and photo specifications are available on the dedicated website <https://indianvisaonline.gov.in/visa/tvoa.html>. International Travellers, whose sole objective of visiting India is recreation, sightseeing, casual visit to meet friends or relatives, short duration medical treatment or casual business visit may apply for eTV.

2. The eTV facility is in addition to the existing Visa services being provided through the Indian High Commission in Maputo. Please visit <http://www.hicomind-maputo.org/maputo.php?id=Visa> to know how to apply at the Indian High Commission in Maputo.

3. The validity of eTV is 30 days from the date of arrival in India. eTV is allowed for a maximum of two visits in a calendar year. eTV once issued on arrival is only single entry, non-extendable, non-convertible & not valid for visiting Protected/Restricted and Cantonment Areas.

4. Applicants from Mozambique may apply online at <https://indianvisaonline.gov.in/visa/info1.jsp> minimum 4 days in advance of the date of arrival with a window of 30 days. Example: If you are applying on 1st September then you can select arrival date from 5th September to 4th October.

5. eTV fee is US\$ 60/- per passenger excluding interchange charge for credit/debit cards. The fee must be paid at least 4 days before the expected date of travel filled by you otherwise application will not be processed. eTV fee once submitted is non-refundable as the fee is for processing of the application and is not dependent on either Grant or Rejection of VISA.

6. eTV shall be granted through email and is available only for ordinary passport holders. The applicant should carry a print of this email and can travel to India through 16 designated international airports (Bangalore, Chennai, Kochi, Delhi, Goa, Hyderabad, Kolkata, Mumbai Thiruvananthapuram, Ahmedabad, Amritsar, Gaya, Jaipur, Lucknow, Tiruchirappalli and Varanasi). However, the foreigner can take **exit** from any of the authorized Immigration Check Posts (ICPs) in India. eTV is not valid for entry from sea ports in India. The eTV scheme entails capture of biometric data of the visitor on arrival at the airport.
